HIP - Sponsored Walk & Push



Date: Saturday 28th September 2024

Location: Ness Botanic Gardens, Neston Rd, Little Neston, Ness CH64 4AY

Time: 11:00 AM (Those on HIP transport will return at 3pm)

So, dust off your walking shoes and get ready for a delightful day at the beautiful Ness Botanic Gardens this September which has 64 acres of plants, wildlife, and breath-taking landscapes. H.I.P is excited to host a sponsored walk to raise awareness and essential funds to support people with head injuries across Cheshire.

Event Details:

There will be 3 routes:

- 1. One that is flat and suitable for wheelchairs
- 2. One suitable for wheelchairs but more up and down
- 3. One that covers 2.5 miles with variety of surfaces

Maps of the various routes will be provided. Distances of route 1. and 2. to follow when confirmed by Ness Botanical gardens. There will be no entrance fee for HIP members/carers/those attending the sponsored walk, but anticipate that you will make individual donations for the event to HIP.







Bring along your packed lunch, there will however be an opportunity to purchase vouchers for tea/coffee & cakes at the entrance for those who would like them.

Everyone who completes the sponsored walk for HIP will receive a free HIP t-shirt and medal in recognition of their achievements. Be sure when confirming your attendance you provide the size you will need for your t-shirt!!!!

We shall be passing out sponsor forms out at our September coffee mornings - for those of you not able to attend please let us know so we can post them out to you. Please share far and wide. We warmly invite our members



Consultation of Personal Independence Payments (PIP)

The UK government launched a consultation on the Personal Independence Payment (PIP) system around modernising support for independent living: the health and disability green paper. The consultation period closed on July 22nd with HIP in Cheshire being one of the 16,000 voices who submitted a response, with the vast majority of these objects to proposed changes.

The consultation was launched in April 2024 to gain an insight into whether benefits are targeted at those most in need. Views were invited from across society to inform potential future reforms. Many organisations have called for the new Labour government to scrap these plans, however at this point in time no further announcement has been made. Our response was focused on concerns around the impact of any proposed future changes to PIP.
